

Vocational Training for the Food & Drink Industry

Certificate in Proficiency in Baking Industry Skills Level 2

This qualification is designed for learners who wish to develop occupational skills and knowledge in the baking industry. It includes units that covers a wide range of craft and automated baking techniques; also food service/retail skills to demonstrate occupational competence in specific job roles such as:

- Bakery operative
- Bakery packaging and distribution operative
- Bakery service/sales operative
- Bakery production operative



We use a Blended Learning approach suited to workplace learning on an individual basis or groups as required.

The Training Advisor will visit the learner within the workplace on a regular basis to support, advise, guide and facilitate workshops and individual one to one learning and development; all visits are in the workplace so there is no need to release staff to college.

Each learner will be appointed a dedicated Training Advisor. An Individual Training Plan will be drawn up and the units for delivery will be agreed by the learner, employer and training advisor. Each visit date will be agreed and progress will be mapped in the form of progress reviews that will also detail work to complete for next visit, date of next visit and any feedback that either party wishes to convey.



This qualification contains the following components

IPQ units. Each unit has a credit value and to achieve the award you have to achieve 27 credits. This usually equates to 12 units. Each learner will need to undertake Essential Skills in Both English & Maths as part of the framework

On completion of the above you will receive a Certificate for a National recognised qualification, These are awarded by Food & Drink Qualifications) FDQ , a very well-known and Nationally recognised awarding body.
